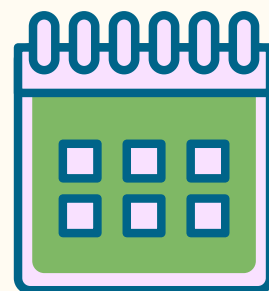

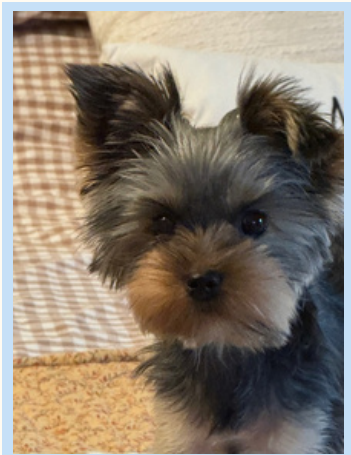

SPRING IS IN THE AIR..

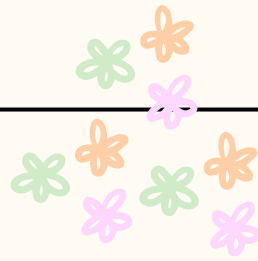
